## **Infectious Disease Control**

The district shall endeavor to safeguard employees and students from the spread of certain infectious diseases and to assure that all schools and work sites are in compliance with State Board of Health rules and regulations regarding the presence of persons who have or have been exposed to infectious diseases deemed dangerous to the public health.

The superintendent is directed to draft procedures to implement these goals.
