What are Scholarships?

A scholarship is an amount of money awarded helping you further your education and you do not have to pay it back.

Scholarships are considered “gift aid.”

Scholarships come from many sources:

- Government
- Corporations
- Colleges, universities, training programs
- Organizations

Scholarship Myths vs. Reality

Scholarships are only for good grades and sports.	You have to write an essay to get a scholarship.	Scholarships that are small are not worth the effort of applying.
<p><i>Many scholarships do not take grades or athletics into consideration and do not have a GPA requirement as part of their criteria.</i></p> <p><i>If scholarships consider your GPA as part of their application, the minimum might be 2.5 rather than a 4.0.</i></p>	<p><i>Not all scholarships require an essay. Reading the application criteria carefully is important.</i></p> <p><i>Essays are more about what you write than how eloquently it is written.</i></p> <p><i>It is more important to follow the instructions and directly address the essay question.</i></p>	<p><i>Remember that every dollar you receive in scholarships is one more you don't have to pay back.</i></p> <p><i>If you win multiple scholarships that are worth smaller amounts, it adds up to a larger overall award.</i></p> <p><i>Scholarship money can help with additional college expenses like books, supplies, food etc.</i></p>

Scholarship Myths vs. Reality

Scholarship competition is too intense.	Searching for scholarships takes too much time.	Scholarships are only for those with financial need.
<p><i>The most important thing is to read all scholarship instructions and rules.</i></p> <p><i>Many times students don't take the time to do everything correctly so they are not even considered.</i></p> <p><i>If you spend time searching, applying and win, think about how much money that would equal per hour if you worked?</i></p>	<p><i>Set aside time to search and apply for scholarships each week.</i></p> <p><i>Use tools inside Naviance Student and others where you can create a profile to narrow your search options,</i></p> <p><i>Reach each description and follow all instructions by scholarship provider so you don't waste time applying.</i></p>	<p><i>There are a lot of scholarships not only focused on financial need.</i></p> <p><i>Scholarships are available based on your interest, talents, academics (known as "merit"), volunteering, and many other extra curricular activities.</i></p> <p><i>Often completing profiles like the National Scholarship Search can help.</i></p>

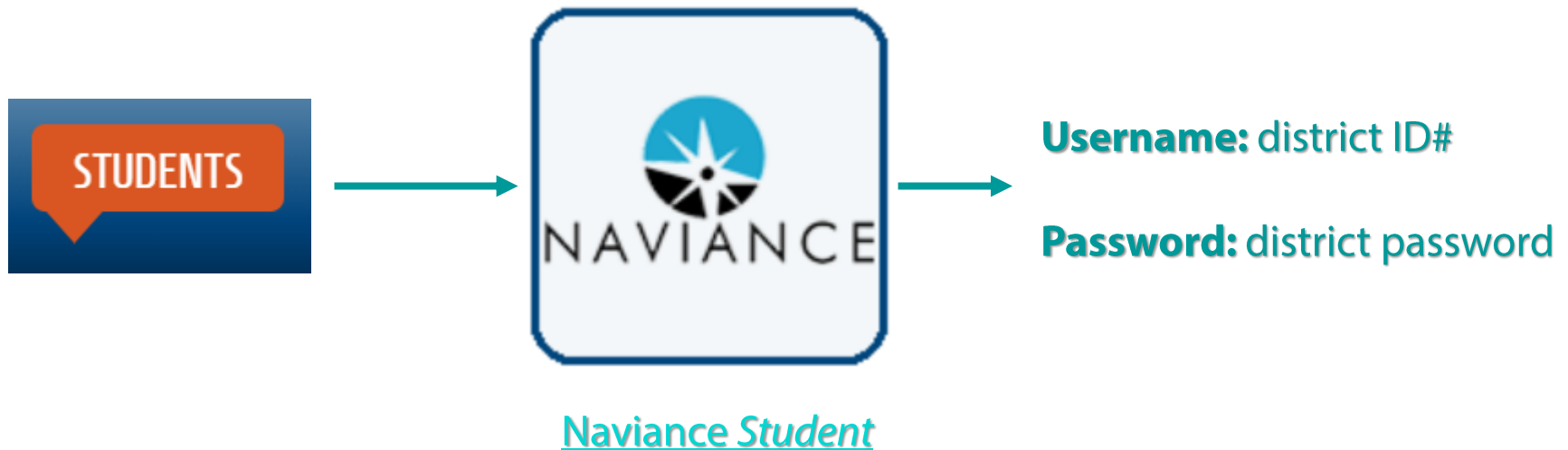

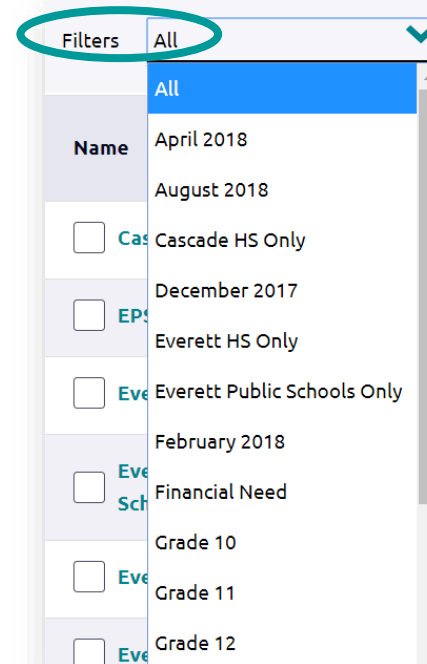
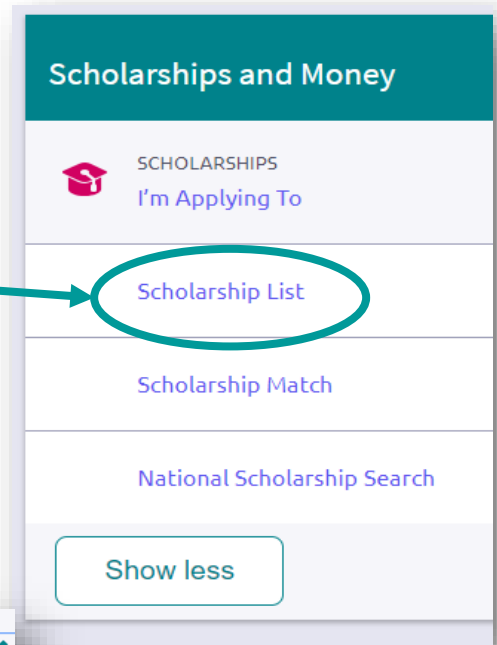
SCHOLARSHIP LIST & MATCH

Scholarship Match has scholarships matching your current profile information in Naviance *Student* with criteria listed within the scholarship.



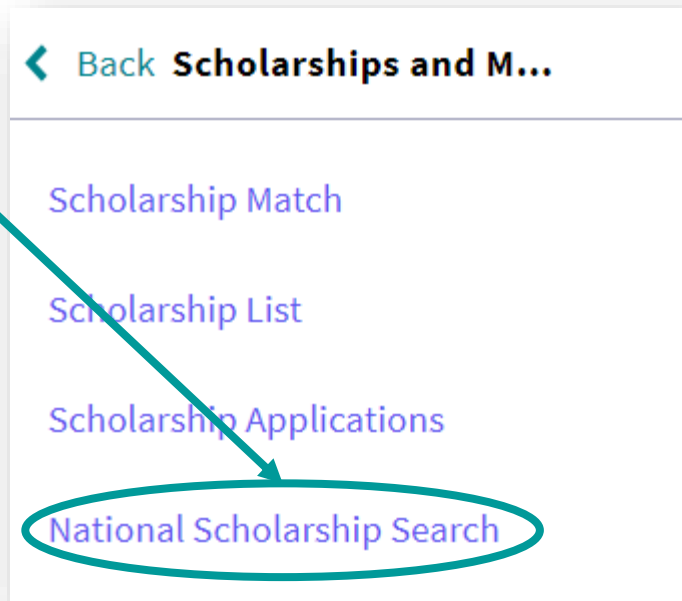



APPLY FOR SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarships at Your School

Each year, your high school posts their own scholarship applications in Naviance *Student*.

Your task is to apply for at least one of your own school's scholarships and **upload your application** to your **task** in Naviance *Student*.

Completing the Application

Follow these steps to apply for your school only scholarship:

1. Filter the Naviance *Student* scholarship list by locating your **school name only**
2. Locate and identify a school only scholarship that fits you based on the criteria provided
3. Complete the application and save!
4. Make note of the scholarship due date and remember to submit **on time**
5. Upload your application to your **task** to save and complete the task

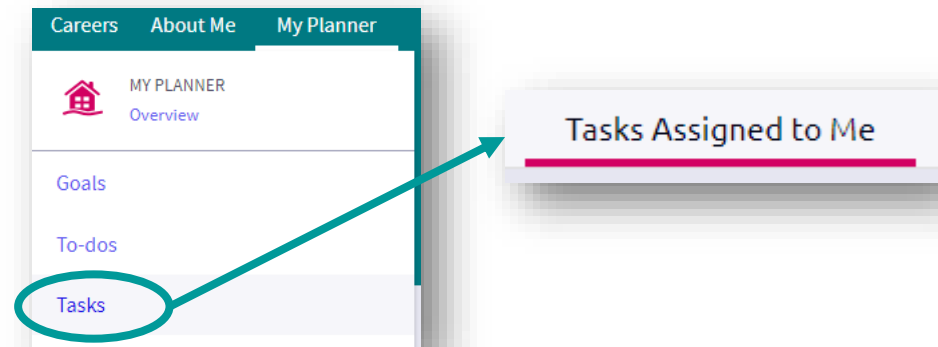

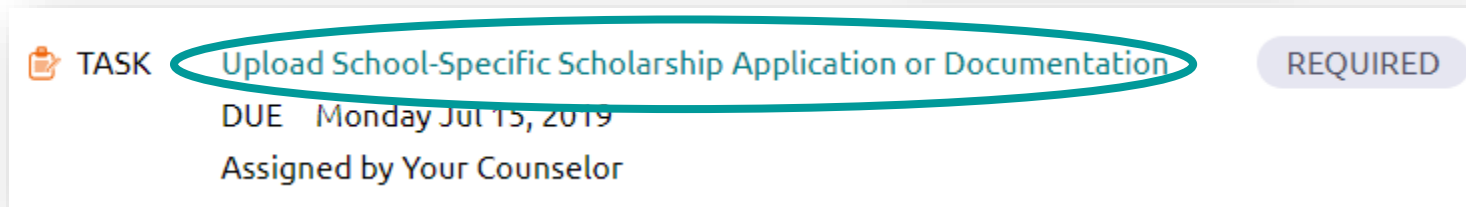

Uploading to a Task

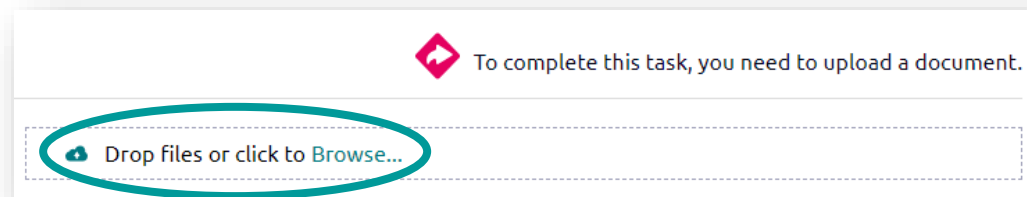
To access your journal click **My Planner > Tasks**
