SHOPPING INVITATION TO AREA SCHOOLS

You are invited to shop for new merchandise donated by World Vision at our storehouse located at the above address in the basement of Volunteers of America.

Our hours are Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm. Other times can be arranged.

The school supplies that are available are: lined paper, spiral notebooks, pencil pouches, pencils, pens, scissors, erasers, index sheets, binders, colored pencils, markers, crayons, rulers, backpacks and glue.

The office supplies that are available are: labels of various sizes, blank business cards, copy paper, photo copy paper, sheet protectors, markers, pens, scotch tape, rubber bands, binders and report covers.

There are a variety of other items—such as paints, stencils, sequined calendar kits, yarns, lunch sacks, McDonalds toys, trading cards, photo card kits, themed stationery items, ‘butcher type paper’, stickers and books. Many of these items are excellent for craft/art classes.

In order to have a smooth process we ask that you:

- Shop every two months ----honor system

- Sign in at the front desk and have school identification

- Take only what you need for your class (cannot shop for other teachers)—unless other arrangements have been made

- List all the items taken on the check out form.

- Part of our agreement with donors is that we mutually insure that no items are returned to local stores nor sold. Your monitoring of this requirement is requested.

- Thank you letters are encouraged and appreciated.
