


Boundary Revisions Under Consideration for Jackson High School



Boundary revisions under consideration for Jackson High School by the High School Growth Mitigation Planning Committee (HSGMPC)

This is <u>not</u> a final recommendation. The committee's final recommendation will be made to the Everett Public Schools superintendent by March 31, 2019.

These current Jackson High School attendance areas are being considered for moving into the Cascade High School attendance area. Numbers 1 through 5 on the map indicate how many of the five small work groups in the HSGMPC are considering this change. E.g., the number 3 signifies that three of the five small work groups in the HSGMPC are considering moving this area from Jackson High School to Cascade High School.

Student Enrollment by Area

The following information shows the number of students currently in grades 6-9 in the areas under consideration for boundary changes. These students will be in grades 8-11 in fall 2020 when the boundary changes are expected to be implemented.

Area 5 = 89

Area 4 = 303


Area 3 = 94

Area 2 = 100 (total of both #2 areas)

Area 1 = 174 (total of both #1 areas)
