## **INSTRUCTION**

## **Service Animals in Schools**

Everett Public Schools acknowledges its responsibility to permit students and/or adults with disabilities to be accompanied by a service animal as required by federal laws and Washington State's law against discrimination. This policy governs the presence of service animals in the schools, on school property, including school buses, and at school activities.

A "service animal" means an animal any dog or miniature horse that is individually trained for the purpose of assisting or accommodating a disabled person's sensory, mental or physical disability to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability, including a physical, sensory, psychiatric, intellectual, or other mental disability. The work or tasks performed by the service animal must be directly related to the individual's disability.

It is a civil infraction to misrepresent an animal as a service animal. A student's The parent/guardian of a student who believes the ir student requires the support of a service animal at school, or an employee who requires a service animal at school, must submit a written request to the building principal. The building principal, in consultation with the designated regional deputy associate/assistant superintendent and Section 504 coordinator or director of special services, as appropriate, will determine whether or not to permit the service animal in school.

Service animals in training are permitted access to public areas of Everett Public Schools such as the gymnasium during a sporting event where any member of the public is permitted to attend. With permission of the superintendent or designee, service animals in training are permitted in private areas of the school, where the general public is not permitted, such as classrooms while school is in session. Training of service animals is permitted by approval of the superintendent or designee.

The superintendent will develop procedures to implement this policy.
