WHAT IS GRADUATION ALLIANCE?

Graduation Alliance is an online high school diploma and GED program that is part of Everett Reengagement Academy. Designed for students who are behind in credits or not currently enrolled in school, students in Graduation Alliance can take classes to prepare for the GED tests, working on just the sections of the classes where they need more practice. Local Advocates help students register for the GED tests and Graduation Alliance covers the cost of the first attempt at each test, saving students \$144! Students are required to pass at least 1 test every 3 months.

Students also attend virtual and/or in-person meetups for at least 30-60 minutes per week. Students must attend at least 2 hours of meetup time per month to remain in good standing. Social meetups are run by Local Advocates and focus on social/emotional needs. These can be virtual or inperson. Study Session meetups are held virtually with the Academic Coaches.

Chromebooks and Wi-Fi hot spots are available to check out from Graduation Alliance at no cost.

HOW TO ENROLL

- Get referred by your counselor or a school staff member
 - Students who are new to Everett Public Schools will need to enroll at their resident high school and meet with a counselor, success coordinator, or admin to be referred.
- Call the enrollment number: 1-888-615-6115
- Attend Strong Start Orientation, take the STAR placement tests, complete enrollment forms, and do your first assignment.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 16-21 years old (must be 16 by September 1 of current school year)
- Significantly behind in credits OR not enrolled in school
- Live within the Everett Public Schools boundaries OR have an approved Choice Transfer request on file
