## EVERETT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2 RESOLUTION NO. 1192

## Authorization to Apply for 180-Day Waiver

**WHEREAS**, the Everett Public Schools Board of Directors ("Board") recognizes that unforeseen natural events, specifically a state of emergency, caused by severe winter storms produced extensive snowfall and ice causing hazardous driving conditions and extended road closures throughout the state; and

WHEREAS, all Everett Public Schools were closed for five days on February 4, 2019, February 5, 2019, February 11, 2019, February 12, 2019, and February 13, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined there exists sufficient need to seek a waiver from the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction from the provisions of the minimum one-hundred eighty (180) student day school year requirement of RCW 28A.150.220(5);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the board finds there is sufficient need for Everett Public Schools to waive one day: February 13, 2019 and to make up four days on June 18, 2019, June 19, 2019, June 20, 2019, and June 21, 2019; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that Everett Public Schools will, in order to maintain compliance with the required instructional hours, convert June 17, 2019 from a half-day of instruction to a full-day of instruction, and will convert the following "Learning Improvement Friday" early release days to full-days of instruction: April 12, 2019, April 19, 2019, April 26, 2019, and May 3, 2019; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that pursuant to WAC 392-129-125, Districtwide emergency closure, and the Governor's Emergency Proclamation 19-02, the Board authorizes an Everett Public Schools application for continuation of state support during a districtwide emergency closure, and authorizes the superintendent to negotiate a memorandum of understanding with the Everett Education Association to amend the 2018-20 collective bargaining agreement to achieve this calendar revision.
