Racial Imbalance Certification for Woodside Elementary School Modernization

A Resolution of the Board of Directors (the "Board") of Everett School District No. 2 (the "District"), certifying that the proposed school construction of Woodside Elementary School will not create or aggravate racial imbalance within the School District boundaries.


WHEREAS, provisions of W.A.C. 392-342-025 and W.A.C. 392-344-035 require certification by the Board concerning racial imbalance prohibition related to construction of facilities; and

WHEREAS, a partial replacement and modernization project is proposed for Woodside Elementary School;


