## EVERETT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2 SNOHOMISH COUNTY, WASHINGTON RESOLUTION NO. 1195

Increase of Appropriation in Capital Projects Fund

**WHEREAS**, Everett School District No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington, is a first-class school district duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the Constitution and the laws of the state of Washington; and

WHEREAS, RCW 28A.505.170 and WAC 392-123-071 provide for a first-class school district to extend its budget for any fund; and

WHEREAS, the multi-year costs for the construction of New Elementary School No. 18, now named Tambark Creek Elementary School, were lower than anticipated in the 2017-18 fiscal year shifting those costs into the 2018-19 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the increase in the 2018-19 projected construction costs for Tambark Creek Elementary School total \$4,517,000; and

WHEREAS, the multi-year costs for the modernization of North Middle School were lower than anticipated in the 2017-18 fiscal year shifting those costs into the 2018-19 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the increase in the 2018-19 projected construction costs for North Middle School total \$10,591,000; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Projects Fund beginning cash/fund balance plus anticipated revenues are sufficient to provide for the additional expenditures;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Directors of Everett Public Schools hereby increases the 2018-19 Capital Projects Fund appropriation amount from \$100,422,147 to \$115,530,147. Pursuant to WAC 392-123-071, the Superintendent shall promptly file two copies of this signed Resolution with the Educational Service District 189.
