The Homeless Children and Youth application in the Education Data System (EDS) for districts to view and certify their Homeless Student data is now open.

The Federal McKinney-Vento Act requires all school districts to identify, enroll, and serve children and youths living in homeless situations. The Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) is required to annually collect and report district-level data regarding homeless children and youths enrolled in public schools. The deadline for districts to review and make any changes to their homeless student data through EDS is July 9.

The Homeless Children and Youth application is pre-populated with data from the Comprehensive Education Data and Research System (CEDARS) and is now available for districts to review.

Districts are required to provide contact information, complete any non-populated fields, and make necessary corrections by July 9. After July 9, the data will be considered certified and the application will lock. Districts will only be able to access the application in “read only” mode after this date.
