Interlocal Cooperative Purchasing Agreement with Snohomish County

WHEREAS, Everett School District ("District") is a duly constituted School District organized and existing under the laws of the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, Snohomish County ("County") is organized under the laws of the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, each party is also a public agency, as that term is defined by RCW 39.34.020; and

WHEREAS, school districts in the State of Washington are authorized by Chapters 28A.320 and 39.34 RCW, to enter into interlocal cooperative agreements for the purchase of various equipment, supplies and services; and

WHEREAS, both Parties are required to make certain purchases by formal advertisement and bid process, which is a time consuming and expensive process; both parties desire to reduce their respective costs in purchasing various equipment, supplies and services, and it is in the public interest to cooperate in the combination of bidding requirements to obtain the most favorable bid for each party where it is in their mutual interest; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors has determined that this Agreement will permit the District to make the most efficient use of its authority by cooperating with the County on a basis of mutual advantage and that it is in its best interest to cooperate and join in certain purchasing activities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of Everett School District No. 2, Snohomish County, Washington finds that an interlocal cooperative agreement between the District and the County should be formed for the purpose of procuring various equipment, supplies and services;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an interlocal cooperative agreement between the District and the County shall allow the purchase or acquisition of goods and services by each Party directly from a third-party vendor if a provision has been made in the lead agency's contract with that third party that permits other agencies to avail themselves of the goods and services offered under the contract; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Directors authorizes the superintendent to enter into an interlocal cooperative purchase agreement with Snohomish County.
