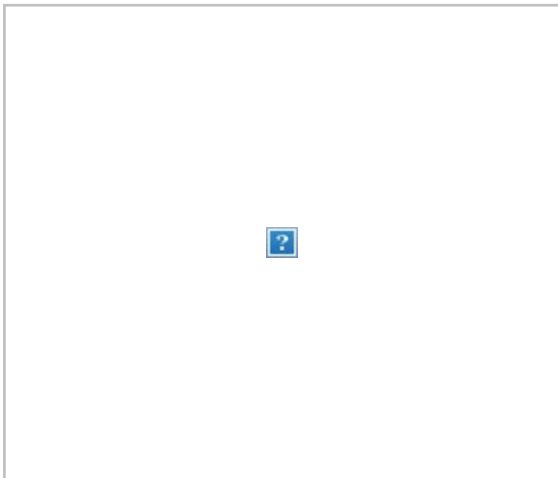


Family Education
