


1. Register in Frontline Professional Growth for **Paraeducators: What We Do Matters Online Training Instructions 19100140**





2. You will be directed to access Frontline: Professional Growth to register for all in-district classes, workshops, and other professional opportunities.




3. In the left navigation pane, select **Activity Catalog**, find the **District Catalog or Calendar** to search for Professional Development offerings.




4. Find an activity by searching “What We Do Matters”. Click “Sign Up Now”


5. Type <https://www.pesb.wa.gov/> into your URL bar to visit PESB’s website.
