Who is eligible?

Families with a child who is:

- ☐ Enrolled in Everett Public Schools or Tomorrow's Hope Child Development Center
- ☐ Eligible for the KIT program
- ☐ 8 years old or younger
- ☐ Chronically absent from school missing 10% or more of their school days (more than 2 in a month or 18 in a year) – for any reason: excused, unexcused, and suspensions.

What are the benefits?

- ⇒ Families are connected to support in school and in the community
- ⇒ CFS's can assist with family access to resources and official documents, work to set goals, and offer different perspectives
- ⇒ Access to flex funding to support success
- ⇒ A team of support helping to address multiple needs and reducing barriers to success in school attendance and beyond
