KINSHIP PROGRAMS

Free programs providing resources and support for those who are caring for relative children and teens

Kinship Navigator: Offers information, referral, and follow-up services to grandparents and other relatives raising kin-children to link them to the benefits and services that they or the children need.

Kinship Caregiver Support Program (KCSP): Provides limited, non-crisis, financial support to eligible kinship caregivers whose kin-child does not have an open DCYF case.*

Provides Information Regarding:

- Kinship Caregiver Support Program funds for basic needs
- Legal and guardianship resources
- Information and referrals for other identified needs
- Department of Children, Youth, and Family Program navigation

*DCYF may offer financial supports for enrolled clients
