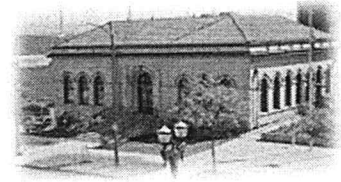

The CRC does **NOT** have access to provisions such as: motel, gas, bus fare, hygiene or clothing vouchers. However, participants who are engaged with specific programs or services may be eligible for supportive services from that program or agency.

The CRC is also unable to intake individuals into the Snohomish County Diversion Center. Those intakes are initiated and provided by embedded Social Workers and the Office of Neighborhoods during their outreach and field work.

MONDAYS:

Eyewear Vouchers 9:00am – 4:30pm

- Bring your current (within the last 12 months) prescription and apply for a voucher for eyewear.

Housing Navigation & Coordinated Entry (Sno. Co.) 9:00am – 4:30pm

- Housing Navigators collect information to assess strengths, determine vulnerability, and explore available options.

Employment Navigation (WorkSource) 9:00am – 4:30pm

- Employment Navigators assist with job readiness skills for those interested in employment. EN's at the Carnegie are focused on working with those impacted by the opioid epidemic. Supportive services may be available for those who qualify.

Healthcare Navigation (CHC) 12:30pm – 4:30pm

- Healthcare Navigators help people access medical coverage through the Healthcare Exchange and facilitate enrollment in State Medical Coverage and other eligible services and programs.

Everett Recovery Café 10:30am – 2:30pm

- Offering information regarding their services and peer support for those seeking or in recovery. Membership is required.

YWCA 2:00pm – 3:30pm

- The YWCA offers deposit assistance to those who qualify. Must be currently homeless or being asked to leave current residence.

TUESDAYS:

Eyewear Vouchers 9:00am – 4:30pm

- Bring your current (within the last 12 months) prescription and apply for a voucher for eyewear.

Housing Navigation & Coordinated Entry (CCS) 9:00am – 4:00pm

- Housing Navigators collect information to assess strengths, determine vulnerability, and explore available options.

Employment Navigation (WorkSource) 9:00am – 4:30pm

- Employment Navigators assist with job readiness skills for those interested in employment. EN's at the Carnegie are focused on working with those impacted by the opioid epidemic. Supportive services may be available for those who qualify.

Healthcare Navigation (UHC) 10:00am - 2:00pm

- UHC Reps help individuals who are on both Medicare and Medicaid get additional benefits like dental, vision, transportation, over the counter essentials & assist with additional programs that are available for help with prescription cost.

Bridgeways – Supported Employment Services 9:00am - 4:00pm (2nd and 4th Tuesdays)

- Primary goals of Supported Employment at Bridgeways - assist in achieving and retaining a job in the community by overcoming barriers in the community related to mental illness.

YWCA 2:00pm – 3:30pm

- The YWCA offers deposit assistance to those who qualify. Must be currently homeless or being asked to leave current residence.

DSHS 1:00pm – 4:30pm

- Apply for or renew benefits, ID vouchers, have award letter printed. Replacement EBT cards are NOT available.

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
