Board swears in newly elected member and elects its new officers

November election winner April Berg takes oath of office.

Annual reorganization results in Caroline Mason as president; Pam LeSesne as vice president.

In November, April Berg was elected to fulfill a six-year term as member of the Everett Public Schools Board of Directors Position 2. Berg was sworn into office by Representative John Lovick.
