



Meals for emergency school closure

We are committed to providing access to the nutrition our students need during this extended emergency districtwide closure. We will be offering meals for pick up at a total of 23 school sites and at least five apartment complexes.

Meal pick-up and order process

- Meals will be available for pick up at 28 sites
 - ◇ We are still working on the times, but when they are determined they will be listed on the order form and available on the website. The times will range from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.
- Lunch orders must be placed between the hours of 2 p.m. and 11:30 p.m. the day prior
- **Preorder** is required each day
 - ◇ The preorder form will be available starting the evening of March 15
 - ◇ Additional meals available for students that drop in, but availability will be limited
- Meals will be free for all children ages 1 - 18 (not just students)
- Students must be present to claim their meal
- Breakfast for the next morning will be given out with lunch
- Adult meals are not available for purchase
- Meals will be available for pick-up based on delivery location selected on the preorder form
 - ◇ Pick-up site does not need to be students home school; they can select the most convenient site
- The lunch menu for the day will be available on the preorder form
- School pick up sites include: **Elementary:** Cedar Wood, Forest View, Garfield, Hawthorne, Jackson Elementary, Jefferson, Lowell, Madison, Mill Creek, Monroe, Penny Creek, Silver Lake, Silver Firs, Tambark Creek, View Ridge, Whittier and Woodside. **Middle:** Eisenhower, Evergreen, Heatherwood and North. **High:** Cascade and Sequoia.
- Apartment Complex pick up sites are still being discussed
