Single Sign On Active employees and substitutes working in EPS will use single sign on technology with a district email address. No Frontline ID or password is used.

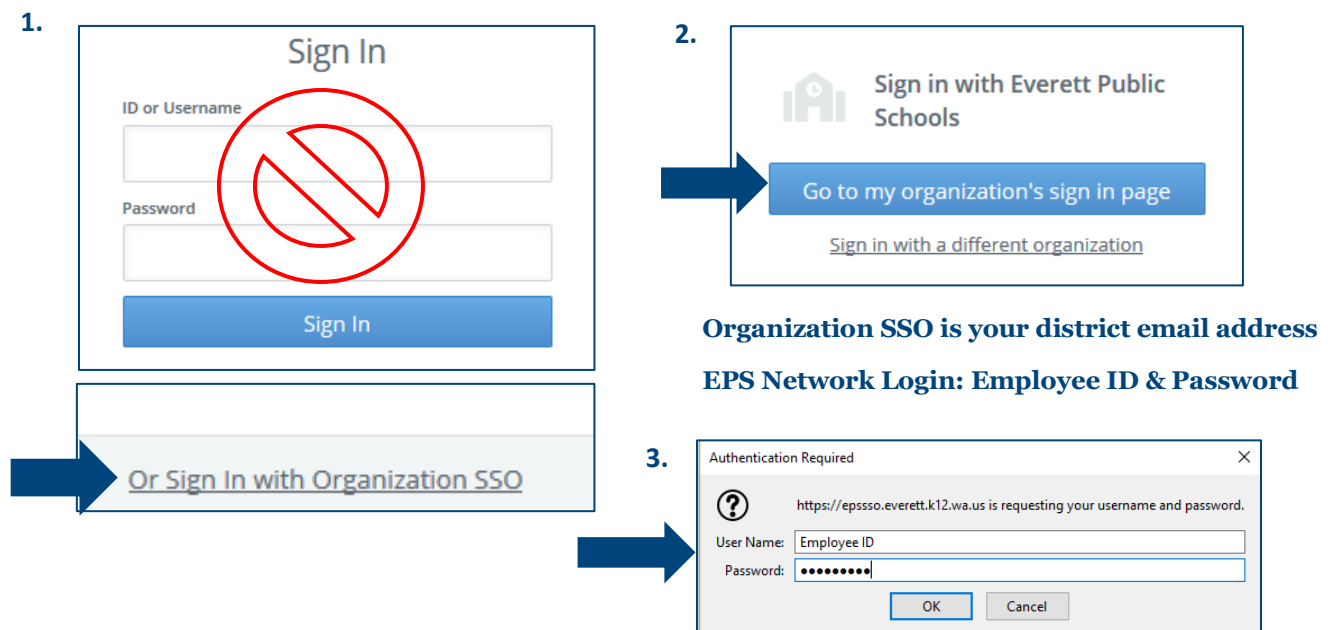
