



Elementary Online Summer Experience 2020 Parent Information

Your child was selected based on the following criteria:

- Students currently in 2nd, 3rd, and 4th grades who are not yet at standard are invited to attend based on specific criteria by grade level.
- Students who are English learners are invited to attend based on their ELPA scores.
- Teachers will invite students who are eligible based on their reading, math, and/or ELPA scores.

How do I register? When are registration forms due?

- Complete the registration form from your child's teacher.
- Registration forms must be turned in by **May 22, 2020**
- Email the registration form to CategoricalPrograms@everettsd.org
- You will receive official confirmation of enrollment in summer school by the school or district.

When and Where?

- Mondays through Thursdays, June 29 — July 30. There is no class on Fridays.
- Classes will be held online; a computer and hot spot will be provided if needed.

What does it cost?

- Elementary Summer Experience is free, paid through state and federal grants funding.

What will my child do each day?

Online Elementary Summer Experience will provide your child with instruction in reading, writing, and math. The daily schedule includes time to connect with the teacher, engage in online learning, small group online learning, and independent learning experiences. Students will participate in a variety of engaging and fun activities that will build their vocabulary and improve their skills. Math content will focus on number sense, place value, and operations and algebraic thinking. The class will have approximately 15-20 students.

Why should my child attend?

Your child will receive small group, focused instruction in key skills for success in the coming year. Your child will have fun learning and exploring!
