

62 Minus Tens

Players 2

Game can be adapted to play individually

Materials

- 62 Minus game board
- 13 colored counters for each player. Each player needs a different color.
- Paper clip and pencil to use as a “spinner”

How to play

1. Player one spins to determine the number to subtract from 62.
2. Player one determines the difference and places a counter on that number on the game board. For example, player one spins a 6 and determines that $62 - 20 = 42$. Player one then places a counter on one 42 on the game board.
3. The next player spins, determines the difference and places a counter on that number on the game board.
4. Players take turns until one player has 3 counters in a row horizontally, vertically, or diagonally.
