




TIP #5: BEGIN WITH THE END IN MIND

 - Career Cluster Finder




TIP #4: CHECK OUT ALL OPTIONS

- What are all the different paths I can take to reach my future career goal?




TIP #3: FIND THE RIGHT FIT

 Colleges I'm Thinking About list




TIP #2: MAKE CONNECTIONS
