Meals are served Monday –Friday (closed on July 3) Lunch and breakfast will be served together as Grab & Go. There will be no seating inside the buildings. Children do not need to be present. Please see the backside of this flyer for information on P-EBT.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Who can eat the free meals provided?

A: Anyone between the ages of 1-18.

Q: Do I need to show my identification?

A: No. We do not ask for any form of identification.

Q: Will I need to show proof of income?

A: No. There are no income guidelines for you to receive free meals.

Q: How many meals can my child receive each day?

A: Each child receives one free lunch, and one free breakfast .

Q: How can I find a site near me?

A: Several different ways are listed at the top of this flyer.

Q: Can my child pick up their meal and bring it home?

A: Yes, due to emergency waivers approved by the USDA, children **must** take their meals home, there is no eating on site.

Q: Does the child have to be present to pick up the meals?

A: No, a parent or guardian may pick up the meals for a child but they must provide the name and age of the child the meal is for.

Q: Will home deliveries be available?

A: No, home deliveries will not be available.
