




Q1: If public health officials believe it is safe to allow in-person instruction, would you be comfortable having your student return to school this fall?






Q2: Would it increase your comfort level if staff were required to wear masks?






Q3: Would it increase your comfort level if students were required to wear masks?






Q5: If returning to school in the fall is not fully in-person, which educational delivery option do you most support for your child?





Q6: If returning to school in the fall requires split/rotating or phased models in order to ensure social distancing requirements, which of the following options do you prefer?


