Hello Everett Public Schools families,

Welcome to the 2020-21 school year. If your child will be cared for outside of your home during the school day, there are some important preparations you should consider before the first day of school. We want to ensure all children are supported and have access to the tools they need for engaged learning in a virtual environment. Below is guidance if your student will be in a childcare setting during the school day:

- Contact the care provider to confirm the availability of WIFI.
- Send your child's Chromebook or other designated device with them every day; charge the device at home in the evening.
- Complete the attached form with your child's Student ID #, password and other details in order to access remote learning on Canvas. Your child's care provider will need this information to support remote learning.
- Send with your student any resources or schedules that your school has made available.
- Confirm that contact information for your care provider is included in the Home Access Center found on the district website. Being listed there will give the provider access to technical support from the district, if necessary. Click here for instructions on how to log in to the Home Access Center.

The district has put together a library of resources to support families with remote learning called **Parent University**.
