

Remote Learning Meals

Meals will be available for students during remote learning either by pick up on a weekly basis or by daily delivery. The pre-order form is now available. First day of meal pick-up and delivery will be September 9. For a printable flyer, [click here](#).

****JUST ANNOUNCED (8-31-20): USDA is extending the free meal waiver until December 31 2020. This means that school meals will be free for ALL children ages 1-18 regardless of their eligibility status. They do not need to attend Everett Public Schools to take advantage of these free meals.****

Weekly Meal Pick up

During the remote learning period, we will offer meals through an electronic pre-order system. Orders will be placed for a 5 day period to be picked up on Wednesday.

- Each meal kit will contain 5 breakfast and 5 lunches.
- Meal kits are to be **pre-ordered weekly, by Monday at noon** for pick up on Wednesday.
- Pre-ordered meal kits will be available for pick up once a week at the location selected in the order.
- Meal kits are free for all children ages 1-18 or persons over 18 years old who are physically or mentally disabled and participating in a public or nonprofit private school program established for children with these disabilities may also participate in this program.
- Submit one order, including all children in your household on the same order

Daily Meal Delivery

For families that are unable to pick up meals on a weekly basis a daily meal delivery option is available

- To sign up for daily meal delivery a weekly pre-order form must be completed by noon on Monday. Delivery will begin on Wednesday.
- Deliveries will be for Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Monday and Tuesday
- Individual delivery days are not available at this time
- Delivery staff will knock on the door and leave the meal by the door, allowing for a contact less delivery

Remote Learning Meal Service Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Do we need to pre-order our meals?

A: Yes. Please use the Meal Pre-Order form found on the district website to order your meals in advance. This allows us to provide contactless curbside service.

Q: Will home deliveries be available?

A: Yes. Pre-order is required for home delivery.

Q: Can I pick up a meal kit if I didn't pre-order?

A: Each location will have extra meal kits on hand but there are no guarantees that your preferred choice will be available.

Q: Do I have to pick meals up at the school my student is enrolled in?

A: No, meals can be picked up at any of our listed locations.

Q: My student will be attending childcare at a school location. Can they get meals?

A: Yes. If your childcare site is receiving free school meals, you cannot do curbside or home delivery meal kits as that would duplicate meals which is not allowed

Q: Who can pick up the meals?

A: The person who completed the pre-order form which could include parent, guardian or even the student. Students do not need to be present when picking up meals.

Q: What if my child can't drink milk or has a medically diagnosed food allergy?

A: Soy milk is offered at each of our meal pick-up sites. Further dietary accommodation requests require medical documentation. Please contact Jenna Lewis for further details: JLewis@everettsd.org

Q: Can I receive a meal kit for a child that does not attend Everett Public Schools?

A: Yes. Meal kits are FREE for ALL children ages 1-18 regardless if they attend Everett Public Schools or not. This is a waiver that has been extended to December 31 2020.

Q: Do I need to provide identification?

A: No, we do not require identification. You will only need to provide the name and age of the children.

Q: When can I pick up meals?

A: You can pick up meals on Wednesdays. Times are listed on our website and the pre-order form.

Q: What if I can't make my pick up time or location that I originally selected?

A: You can go to a different location or time slot that day or call the Food & Nutrition department to discuss possible alternate arrangements.

Q: Can I pick up only 1 day worth of meals or just breakfast?

A: No. At this time we are only doing 5 day meal kits. You will receive 5 days worth of breakfast and lunch on pick-up day.

Q: My student is over 18 but is part of the GOAL program, can they still get meals?

A: Yes, persons over 18 years old who are physically or mentally disabled and participating in a public or nonprofit private school program established for children with these disabilities may also participate in this program.

Q: Are the meals free?

A: Yes. Meals are free for all children ages 1-18 until December 31 or until USDA funds run out. We encourage you to still apply for free or reduced lunch online at <https://frapps.horizonsolana.com/EVEP01>. Free and reduced approved applications help fund other programs and can also help waive other fees for your family.

PRE-ORDER MEAL KITS

Choose one of two ways to receive your FREE pre-ordered meal kits. Meals are free to all children ages 1-18. They do not need to be enrolled with the school district.

- Curbside Pick-Up**
 - 5 breakfast, 5 lunches per child
 - 3 meal kit options
 - Pick-up on Wednesday
 - Children do not need to be present-be ready to provide their name and ages

- Home Delivery**
 - 1 breakfast, 1 lunch per child
 - Meals delivered daily Wednesday thru Tuesday
 - Must commit to the 5 days
 - 2 meal kit options
 - Pre-order is required everettisd.org/page/37760
