# Learning Model



## School begins in 100% remote learning

### Get to know the stages

#### Stage 1: 100% Remote Learning

- All students participate in distance learning.
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#### Stage 2: Hybrid Learning

- Some students will participate onsite with in-person instruction two (2) days a week. This set of students will be more clearly defined in September, as the COVID progression is monitored by the health district and guidance from OSPI and the state are finalized. All other students participate in remote learning.
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# Learning Model



## School begins in 100% remote learning

### Stage 3: Hybrid Learning

- Students from stage 2, as well as an additional cohort of students will be onsite with in-person instruction two (2) days a week. This set of students will be more clearly defined in September. All other students participate in remote learning.



### Stage 4: Hybrid Learning

- Students from stage 2 and 3, as well as an additional cohort of students will be onsite with in-person instruction two (2) days a week. This set of students will be more clearly defined in September. All other students participate in remote learning.



### Stage 5: 100% In-Person Learning

- All students and staff participate onsite with in-person instruction five (5) days a week.

## Meals

- USDA extended free meal waiver until December 31 – school meals are free for all children ages 1-18 regardless of their eligibility status.
- 14 school sites providing meals to our community
  - Morning, noon and evening pickup locations
  - 5-day meal kit prepared for pick up on Wednesdays
- 61,220 meals served in the first two weeks of school
