School landing pages

This Wednesday after 6 pm the work to update the look for the district website will begin.

The district homepage and each school homepage will be updated, and key district resources will have a link on every page of the website. This change will be our first iteration but over the course of October we will be working to confirm with each department standards and add an approval process for site revisions through the Communications Department.

Our families are asking for consistency and up to date resources. Schools will be asked to do regular audits of their sites to remain up to date.

District site

- Icons on every page going to quick reference and FAQs
- Overview pages will be highest trafficked links
- Department and Program landing page will have staff directory included.

School homepage changes

- Each school homepage will be standardized and mirror the district homepage layout
 - o a multimedia gallery
 - school-based set of icons for consistency and quick reference links to important information
 - o Headlines replacing announcements which can include an article, link or image
- Quicklinks, calendar, contact information and social media feed will be on the page as well.

On the initial launch the main page will have some common images and news articles. On October 1 training materials will be provided to assist webmasters in collaboration with Communications to update to more school-specific items

October 1 will be a district wide review day – we will ask departments and schools to go through their pages and request support for anything that looks off after the new template is applied.






Website Update for Teaching Staff (this is being sent to teaching staff)
