



High School & Beyond Plan


The **High School and Beyond Plan** a survey taken each year from 8th grade to 12th grade.

Students think about their future goals and how to accomplish them based on their interests and exploring future career options.

Students complete the survey starting in 8th grade then update it each year based on their changing interests or goals.

Transcript

Your transcript is a paper summarizing your classes, grades, and cumulative GPA.



GPA

Based on the grades you earn each semester, your GPA or *Grade Point Average* is calculated.

This number indicates the average of the grades you receive

*Most schools use a point system from 0-4.

A = 4.0 points

A- = 3.7 points

B+ = 3.3 points

B = 3.0 points

B- = 2.7 points

C+ = 2.3 points

C = 2.0 points

C- = 1.7 points

D = 1.0 points

F = 0.0 points

Credit

For every class you pass each semester you receive 0.5 credit.



*In high school, you will need 24 credits total in 4-years to graduate.

MS for HS Credit


Students can take middle school courses for high school credit. After the first semester of high school, these courses will appear on the official transcript.

Electives

Throughout high school you will take exploratory classes based on your personal interests called "elective" classes.

Advanced Placement (AP)

Many colleges will award credit or waive requirements for demonstrated proficiency through the AP exams.

Students can begin taking AP courses as early as 9th grade.

*If you are interested in AP courses, also check out the AP Capstone program.






