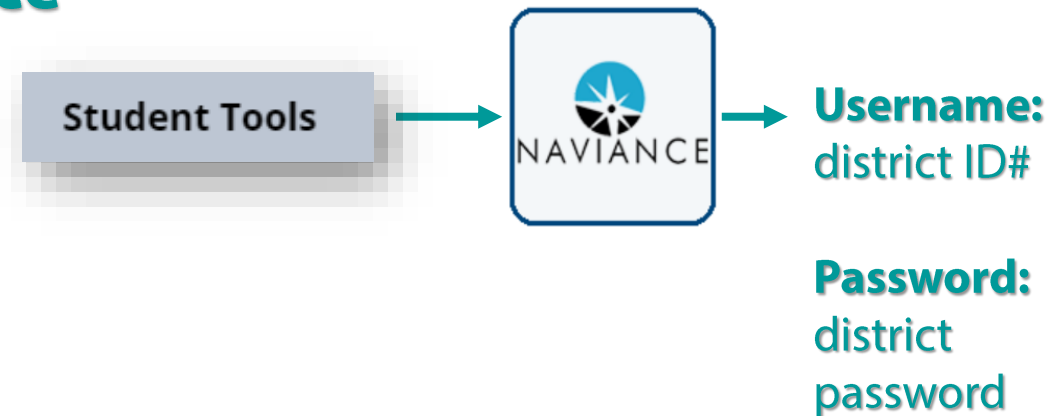

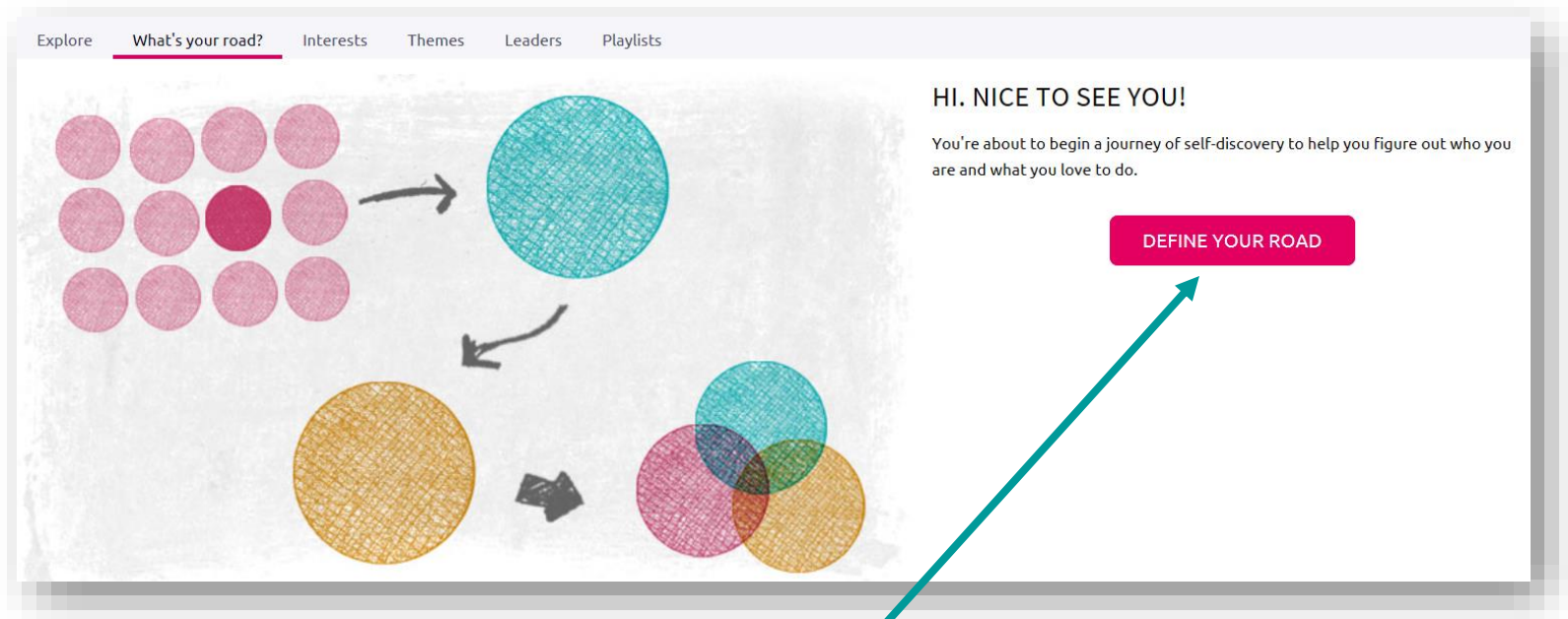
Begin With the End in Mind

When choosing classes for the upcoming year, **begin with the end in mind** and think about your future career path.

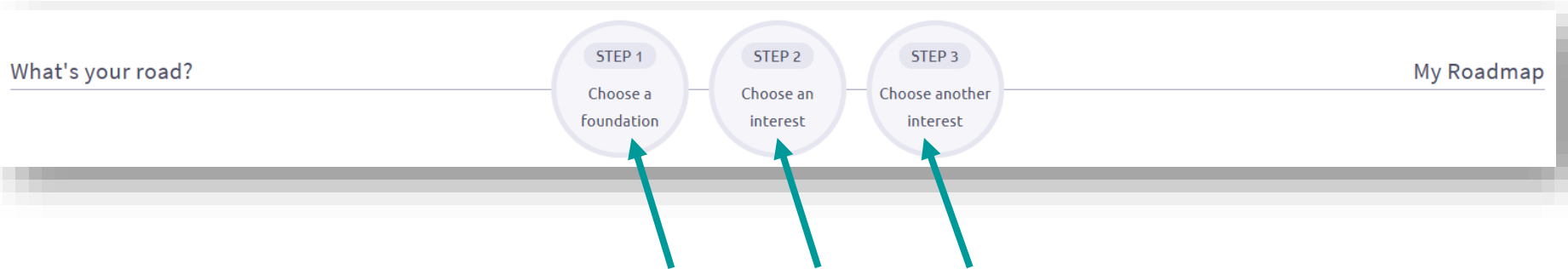
“What do I want to do after high school and what classes will help me reach my goal?”
