

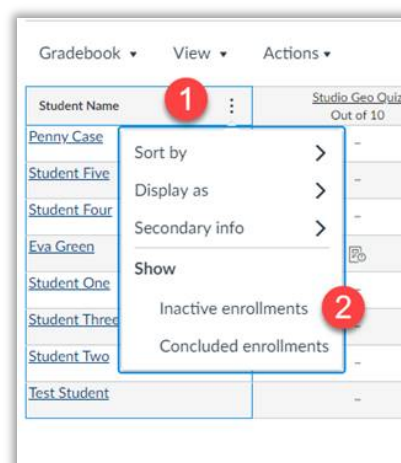
Canvas Inactive Enrollments

Inactive enrollments

With the onset of remote learning from home and the hybrid scheduling on the horizon, schedule changes have added challenges for capturing previously graded work. In order to preserve work completed by students in the first part of the semester who have had to have their schedule changed, the nightly integration is being updated to set students to “inactive” rather than remove the view of their enrollment and work completely from the course.

Updates to the process to shift withdrawn students has been updated so that students dropped as of November 2nd will remain viewable on the People menu with an indication they are inactive. As it approached the quarter mark in the semester and schedule changes aligned to hybrid scheduling, it became more important for inactive students to remain in Canvas courses as this allows teachers, students, and parents access to all grading and assessment information in the Canvas Gradebook.

When working in the gradebook inactive students are hidden by default. If you need to view grading and assessment information for an inactive student click on the ellipsis menu (3 dots) at the top of your gradebook roster and select inactive enrollments.



Inactive students automatically show up in the People menu with an “Inactive” tag. They cannot be hidden. The observers for a student can be removed by the course Teacher.
