As indicated in my <u>January 13 message</u> about remote work, unless you are needed to support the return of students to school buildings, you will continue to work as you are currently working until the region data supports moving forward to Phase 2, according to the Governors <u>"Healthy Washington – Roadmap to Recovery"</u>. This week the Governor announced our county has moved into phase 2.
