

ESEBT Board Report November 2012

The Wellness Challenge

- o 119 participants updated their activity to date in November
- o 402 logged activity in October compared to 328 this time last year.
- o Wellness Challenge 2013 has been designed and is in the development process.
 - Launch Date January 7th 2013

Seasonal Campaign

- Walktober concluded October 31st
 - 464 participants registered, 35 teams
 - 249 participants logged physical activity 21 or more days of the month
 - **Prior** to participating in Walktober 34% (161 participants) of the 464 who registered were exercising 3 days or less a week.
 - After participating in Walktober 64% (300 participants) were exercising 4 or more days a week
 - Survey Monkey Post Walktober Survey:
 - 88 respondents
 - 87% said that they were more physically active as a result of participating in Walktober
 - o 94% said they would like to see Walktober back again next year

Health Fairs and Flu Vaccine Clinics

- o 656 *Flu Vaccines* at 6 district locations
- Over 40 health and wellness vendors
- Survey Monkey Post Vaccine Clinic Survey:
 - 325 respondents
 - 91% said it was not their first flu vaccine
 - 93% chose to have their vaccine at one of our clinics because it was convenient
 - 91% chose to have their vaccine at one of our clinics because it was FREE
 - 75% visited with the health fair vendors
 - 92% said they felt they would have fewer sick days this year as a result of getting a flu vaccine

Community Events:

- Making Strides Walk Snohomish
 - Team Everett Public Schools 25 walkers compared to 8 last year.
 - Raised \$850 compared to \$250 last year.
 - Goal for next year: 100 walkers
