Good afternoon –

I hope you and your family are staying safe and healthy.

We are very excited to begin our phased return of students to school buildings as we welcome Developmental Kindergarten, STRIVE, and Life Skills students back into the classroom five (5) days a week and Developmental Pre-K four (4) days a week starting next Tuesday, January 19. All other students will continue to participate in remote learning at this time.

Impacted families were notified on January 4 and have been preparing for the exciting return to classrooms with their teachers.

Even though COVID cases in the county are still high, we can bring small groups of students back into the buildings because of good safety planning, preparations and sufficient PPE. We are following sound protocols aligned with expert health guidance to ensure we are doing everything we can to protect the health of our students and staff.
