

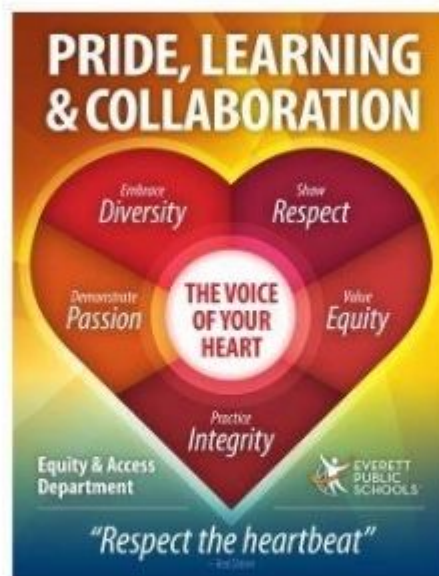

District Level Natural Leaders Trainers

- Natural Leaders who completed 100 hours of Washington Alliance for Better Schools (WABS) training in the development and facilitation of school NL groups.
- Trainers will provide guidance, support, and skill-building to the school NL team.

Staff Lead Responsibilities

- Staff Lead will work with the NL Parent(s) to coordinate the school's NL activities.
- Staff Lead to report NL monthly activities to WABS via WABS 2020-21 Natural Leaders Activity (Oct. 2021).
- Staff Lead compensated per diem, hourly rate, not to exceed 4 hours per month.**
- Additionally, each school receives \$750 per year for NL events supporting the School Improvement Plan.
- Staff Lead to work with the Office Manager in purchasing items for the events.
- Contact Cathy Parken for budget code for online timecard and purchases.

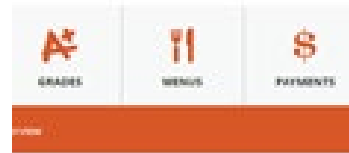

Equity of opportunity is key to the district's mission to inspire, educate, and lead to achieve to high standards, contribute to our community, and improve.

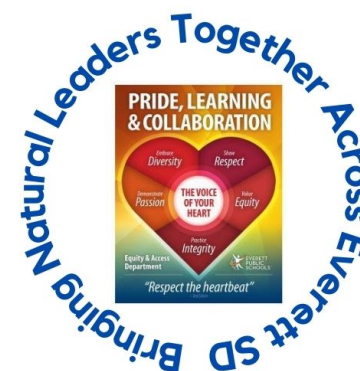
