

### **New [Policy 2005](#), School Improvement Plans**

Legal counsel is recommending adoption of this new policy because the statute requires it and because the WSIF goal in [Policy 2004](#), Accountability Goals, are part of the statute that refers to the School Improvement Plans.

### **[Policy 3131](#) and [Procedure 3131P](#), School Attendance Area Changes and Transfers**

Proposed revisions to the policy correct out of date language regarding the district's obligation to provide access to OSPI's annual enrollment options information booklet. Revisions to the procedure clarify the application process including removing reference to the paper request form. This will be the second year using the online process. Paper forms will still be made available to parents upon request.

### **[Policy 3140](#) and [Procedure 3140P](#), Release of Resident Students**

Proposed revisions to the policy move procedural items to the procedure and correct out of date language regarding the district's obligation to provide access to OSPI's annual enrollment options information booklet. Revisions to the procedure clarify the process necessary for district students to be released and includes the addition of language moved from the policy.

### **[Policy 3141](#) and [Procedure 3141P](#), Nonresident Students**

Proposed revisions to the policy correct out of date language regarding the district's obligation to provide access to OSPI's annual enrollment options information booklet and adds language regarding State data system requirements. Revisions to the procedure include language regarding uniform discipline rules applying to both resident and nonresident students and clarifies to parents that the appeal process for nonresident students may take longer as the appeals go through OSPI and encourages parents not to wait to enroll their student in their resident school/district.
