

Assesses the victim including shake, shout and sternal rub		
Call/instruct someone to call 911 and activate school emergency response		
Obtains and correctly administers Naloxone following the steps below:		
1. Lay the person on their back to administer Naloxone		
2. Remove medication from box, peel back the tab with a circle to open		
3. Hold the Naloxone spray with your thumb on the bottom of the red plunger and two fingers on either side of the nozzle.		
4. Tilt the person's head back, provided support under the neck with your hand		
5. Gently insert the tip of the nozzle until the fingers on either side of the nostrils are against the bottom of the person's nose, hold it there.		
6. Press the red plunger firmly to give the dose of Naloxone nasal spray into the person's nose.		
7. Remove Naloxone nasal spray from the nostril after giving the dose.		
8. Turn and position the person to their side (recovery position)		
9. Monitor patient and administer rescue breathing if needed. If the person does not respond by waking up, to voice or touch, or breathing normally, another dose may be given. Additional dose of Naloxone nasal spray may be administered every 2-3 minutes, if available, or until EMS arrive.		
10. If needed, use steps 2-8 to administer additional doses. Use a new Naloxone nasal spray each time and use the other nostrils.		
11. Put the used Naloxone nasal spray back in the box and give to EMS for disposal		
12. Document administration according to district policy & procedure.

How to use Narcan (Naloxone) Nasal Spray	
<p>Remove Narcan nasal spray from the box. Peel back the tab with the circle to open.</p>	
<p>Hold the Narcan nasal spray with your thumb on the bottom of the red plunger and two fingers on either side of the nozzle.</p>	
<p>Tilt the person's head back and provide support under the neck with your hand. Gently insert the tip of the nozzle into one nostril, until your fingers on either side of the nozzle are against the bottom of the person's nose, hold there.</p>	
<p>Press the red plunger firmly to give the dose of Narcan nasal spray. Remove Naloxone nasal spray from the nostril after giving the dose and place person in the recovery position.</p>	
<p>Remove Naloxone nasal spray from the nostril after giving the dose and position the person into the recovery position.</p>
