

Policy 3200, Student Rights and Responsibilities

WSSDA is recommending deletion of this policy as elements of the policy have been incorporated into proposed revisions to Policy 3300 and Procedure 3300P, Student Discipline. These previously separate but interrelated policies work better and are less confusing synthesized into one holistic policy.

Policy 3300, Student Discipline

WSSDA has provided recommended revisions that incorporate recent changes in our state's student discipline laws, including House Bill 1541 and comprehensive revisions to Chapter 392-400 WAC that eliminated the legal foundation for zero-tolerance student discipline policies. Districts are required to use proactive, instructional, and restorative approaches to behavior while keeping students in the classroom to the maximum extent possible. The proposed revisions also refer to proposed new Policy 3401 and Procedure 3401P, Social Emotional Climate. Revisions to Procedure 3300P are ongoing and will be provided at a later date.
