- Grades 6-7 keep their technology over the summer
 - Collect all grades devices, charging cords, digital pen/stylus, and hotspots from those who will be leaving the district
- Building-specific schedule-During the week of May 24 to May 27 Scott Jenkins will host meetings to determine specifics of collection and outlines for deploying for the start of school
- Collection of technology June 18-23 combined with collecting other school materials at each school's designated locations

Elementary School Devices

- Collecting 5th graders devices, charging cords, digital pens/stylus
 - * Exception students attending summer school.
 - End of summer collection is important to then reimage student computers
- Grades K-4 keep their technology over the summer
 - Collect all grades devices, charging cord, and hotspots from those who are leaving the district.
- Schools are planning their collection of technology along with other school materials following this format:
 - o June 18: Group B students
 - o June 21: Group A and remote students (drop off)

Attendance-June 21st
