Onsite COVID vaccination clinic for students ages 12 and above



Everett, WA—Everett Public Schools, through a partnership with the Snohomish County Vaccine Taskforce, is offering an onsite COVID vaccination clinic for students ages 12 and above. The vaccine being provided is the Pfizer vaccine.

Students can get the vaccination if they are age 12 and above and must have a parent or guardian with them to be vaccinated.

The clinic will be held at Evergreen Middle School (7621 Beverly Lane, Everett 98203) and participants are encouraged to have an appointment.

- First dose: Wednesday, June 9 from 4 to 7 p.m.
- Second dose: Wednesday, June 30 from 4 to 7 p.m.
