Procedure 2114P, Online Learning

Revisions remove the reference to specific grade levels for online learning courses and programs.

Procedure 2214P, Alternative Learning Experience (ALE) Courses

Revisions remove the reference to specific grade levels for alternative learning experiences.

Policy 3240 and Procedure 3240P, Student Conduct Expectations and Sanctions

Proposed deletion of this policy and procedure is recommended by WSSDA because much of the information is no longer part of the current legal framework and other policies and procedures address any information that continues to be relevant.

Policy 3520 and Procedure 3520P, Student Fees, Fines, and Charges

HB 1176 has amended RCW 28A.635.060 which allowed school districts to withhold a student's grades, transcript and/or diploma in the event the student did not make proper restitution for fines or damage charges levied for lost or damaged textbooks, library books or equipment. Districts may no longer hold the grades or transcripts of a student with an unpaid fee or fine.
