

## Field Trip Information Fall 2021

Based on the latest guidance, the following are the current guidelines for field trips for the 2021-22 school year. It is likely this guidance will be updated over the summer prior to the start of school.

It would be important to have <u>all refund policies reviewed</u> in case phases or requirements change before your trip.

OSPI has given the following guidance: School related and sponsored extracurricular activities including field trips must follow all relevant Healthy Washington: <u>Roadmap to Recovery</u> guidance.

There are different requirements depending on your type of trip.

## **Overnight Group Camps**

Full document with guidance: Overnight Group Camps

Highlights include:

- Staff and campers must either be vaccinated or have negative COVID test no more than 3 days prior to start of camp.
- Camp capacity determined by providing 6-feet distancing in sleeping quarters
- Masking and other requirements listed in document
- Daily screening required

## Indoor Entertainment

**Full document with guidance: Indoor Entertainment** 

Guidance is for things like indoor playgrounds, trampoline facilities

- Most requirement pertain to the business owner
- Masking, symptom screening, appropriate transportation (follow school protocol)
- Bowling has its own document.
- Museums have their own document.

## **Outdoor Entertainment**

- Most requirement pertain to the business owner
- Masking, symptom screening, appropriate transportation (follow school protocol)
- Zoos and Aguariums have their own document
