Regarding: COVID vaccination availability

Good afternoon families! I hope you are doing well and are finishing the school year strong!

We are pleased to offer, through a partnership with the Snohomish County Vaccine Taskforce, an onsite COVID vaccination clinic for students ages 12 and above. The vaccine being provided is the Pfizer vaccine.

This means your student can get the vaccination if they are age 12 and above by registering below. Students age 12-17 must have a parent or guardian with them to be vaccinated.

The clinic will be held at Evergreen Middle School (7621 Beverly Lane, Everett 98203) on Wednesday, June 9 from 4 to 7 p.m. The second dose will be at Evergreen Middle School on Wednesday, June 30 from 4 to 7 p.m.
