Commitment to Strategic Planning

The board recognizes that the goals of high-quality education for all students and increasing student achievement require structures, processes, skills and ways of thinking that must be established for the district. Therefore, the board commits itself to engage regularly in strategic planning in order to provide clear strategic priorities priority student outcomes, strategic themes, objectives and initiatives to align the work of the district. Periodic comprehensive strategic planning will enable the district to respond to new developments and continually improve education within the discipline of the planning process.

The strategic plan adopted by the district will be subject to and consistent with the constitutions and statutes of the United States and Washington State. Policies adopted by the board will be consistent with the strategic plan.

The board directs the superintendent to develop procedures for reviewing and developing annually, with district and school administration and board, specific strategies for accomplishing the strategic goals priority student outcomes; monitoring, evaluating and reporting, on an annual basis, the district's progress toward achieving the strategic plan goals objectives and revising the entire strategic plan at least every ten (10) years. The review will provide an opportunity for community members, parents, staff and students to share their vision and expectations for Everett Public Schools' educational program. Through the strategic planning process, the board affirms its commitment to continuing and active involvement with the community, parents, staff and students.
