Policy 1810 Annual Goals and Objectives

Policy 1822 Continuing Education for Board Members

Proposed revisions are to comply with [SB 5044](#), "AN ACT Relating to equity, cultural competency, and dismantling institutional racism in the public school system." Beginning with the 2022 calendar year, each member of a board of directors shall complete a governance training program once per term of elected office. If the director is appointed or elected to a first term of office, the director must complete a governance training within two years of appointment or certification of the election in which they were elected. Governance training programs completed by directors must be aligned with the cultural competency, diversity, equity, and inclusion standards for school director governance provided by WSSDA.

Policy 3600 and Procedure 3600P Student Records

Revisions are to comply with [HB 1176](#) regarding withholding of transcripts and diplomas.

Procedure 6700P Food and Nutrition Program

Revisions are to comply with [HB 1342](#)—Eliminating Lunch Copays. To assist families and promote the health and academic success of students who qualify for reduced-price school breakfasts and lunches, the legislature has eliminated breakfast and lunch copays for qualifying kindergarten through twelfth grade students.
