Procedure 2145P, Suicide Prevention

Revisions are to comply with <u>HB 1373</u> which requires that contact information for a suicide prevention organization, depression or anxiety support organization, eating disorder support organization, substance abuse support organization, and a mental health referral service for children and teens be listed on the home page of each public school website. This allows for immediate access to behavioral health services often prevents suicide, attempted suicide, and other self-harm; and students in public schools often have access to and spend time on the website for their school.

Policy 5160 and Procedure 5160P, Sexual Harassment

Revisions are based on the 2020 Title IX final rules. Rather than inserting the full language of the 2020 Title IX rules, the current revision incorporates a reference to the updated procedures and definitions in <u>Policy 3205</u> and <u>Procedure 3205P</u>, Sexual Harassment of Students. Please note, however, the Department of Education (DOE) is planning some type of action regarding these rules. President Biden has issued an executive order requiring the DOE to conduct a comprehensive review of the 2020 final rule. This review could result in suspension, revision, and/or rescission of the 2020 final rule, and a new rulemaking process.

Procedure 5224P, Professional Learning

Proposed revisions are to comply with <u>SB 5044</u>, "AN ACT Relating to equity, cultural competency, and dismantling institutional racism in the public school system." SB 5044 prescribes equity training for staff. Separate legislation from 2019, <u>SB 5082</u>—Social Emotional Learning, identified and prescribed professional training for staff related to social emotional learning.
