

### October 4 is COVID vaccination eligibility deadline

If you received your first dose of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccination, October 4 is the date you should get your second dose. If you have not been vaccinated yet, you may still get the Johnson & Johnson vaccination by October 4 to fulfill the requirement set by the state to be fully vaccinated by October 18, 2021.

Vaccine	Series Dose Requirement	First Dose no later than	Second Dose	Completed Series	Fully Vaccinated
Pfizer	2 doses, 21 days apart	9/13/2021	10/4/2021	10/4/2021	10/18/2021
Moderna	2 doses, 28 days apart	9/6/2021	10/4/2021	10/4/2021	10/18/2021
Johnson & Johnson	Single dose	10/4/2021	N/A	10/4/2021	10/18/2021
