## **MANAGEMENT SUPPORT**

## Naming Schools, and Facilities, and Teams, and Use of School Mascots, Images, or Logos

The district schools shall be named by the board of directors. Additionally, the board, at its discretion, may assign names to other buildings and physical properties in the district.

Everett Public Schools is located in Snohomish County, which is a county that also contains Coast Salish tribal lands, including the Tulalip Indian Reservation. Therefore, beginning January 1, 2022, Native American names, symbols, or images may not be used as school mascots, logos, or team names unless the Tulalip Tribes have been consulted and have authorized use of the name, symbol, or image as a mascot, logo, or team name through an appropriate tribal enactment or resolution.

## **Dedication Plaques**

A permanent dedication plaque will be installed at each new facility, and at each facility when a major modernization or major addition project occurs.

The superintendent shall implement procedures addressing the specific elements of this policy.
