Date	Action
November 2021	Assess family engagement at each school
November 2021	Provide resource folders for all families whose children are newly identified for special services
December 2021	Identify existing community partners by region and school
May 2022	Implement a customer service plan at the district office and each school
May 2022	Create a "Get Involved" opportunity on the district website to increase community and family engagement
January 2023	Create an information hotline for Everett Public Schools information
2023	Create two regional access hubs with a family support specialist to provide services to families
2023	All schools will host a social-emotional learning program for families

- ✓ All staff members will have the confidence to welcome diverse families in their schools and classrooms.
