

# Installing Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop from Software Center

This is a quick guide to installing Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop from Software Center.


1. From your Windows Task Bar, click the Windows icon and start typing Software Center. Click Open.




2. Click Applications. Click Adobe CC Desktop.

4. Click Installation Status to check the installation process.




5. Status will change to Installed once complete.




# Installing Adobe Creative Cloud Apps

2. The Adobe Creative Cloud desktop is where all the Adobe products can be installed from.


**Note:** Adobe products are very robust and can take up a lot of memory. It is advised that only necessary apps are installed.




## Adobe Acrobat DC


1. To install Adobe Acrobat DC, click Install from the Adobe Creative Cloud Desktop.




2. Once Acrobat DC has installed, click Open.




3. Upon initial login, a prompt to make Adobe Acrobat default will pop up. Click Yes.



#### 4. Click Continue to set default.




## 5. Click Change.




#### 6. Select Adobe Acrobat DC then click OK.


